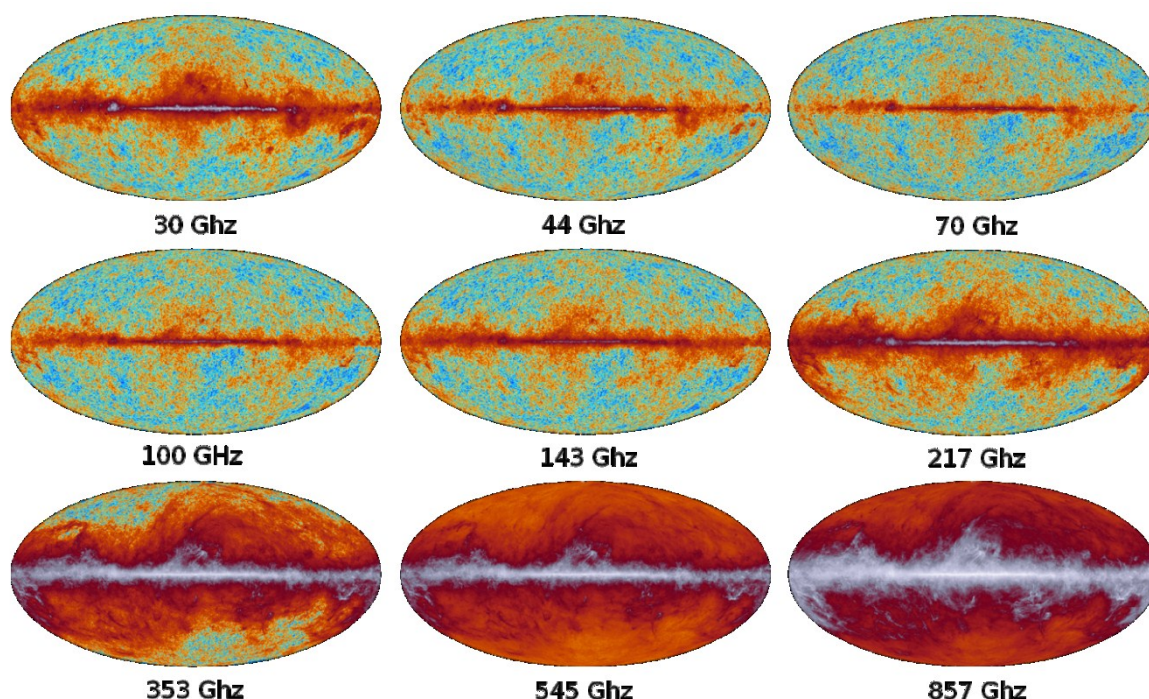




Cosmology results from Planck.
