
What is Science Communication?







classical vs modern formats

- Classical:
 - Inform about research results
 - Presenting scientists and science, hardly any active participation of scientists
 - No feedback loop
 - Hardly any participation
- Modern:
 - Main goal is to create a dialogue about science
 - Interactivity is central to most formats
 - Active roles for both scientists and the audience
 - Communicating processes and values as well as results
